Parental Involvement and Participation

The board of education of the Huron public schools recognizes that a child's education is a responsibility shared by both school and parent/guardian. This shared responsibility requires that parents/guardians actively participate in the education of their children, and that they are informed of the educational practices affecting their children.

It is the intent of the board of education that the district shall provide opportunities for the development of parenting skills. This will include training/information regarding appropriate types of parental involvement which demonstrates techniques designed to assist kindergarten through grade 12 parents with the child's learning at home.

It is further the intent of the board of education that the district shall continue to identify and work toward the elimination of barriers that impede parent involvement.

Parent Involvement in School Management

Each school and/or department will have parents/guardians as members of the school planning council.

Each school and/or department will develop an action plan for parent/guardian involvement.

Staff Development in Parent Involvement

Staff development for administrators, teachers, and other appropriate staff members will be provided to enhance family-school relationships in a manner which ensures maximum educational progress for each child.
