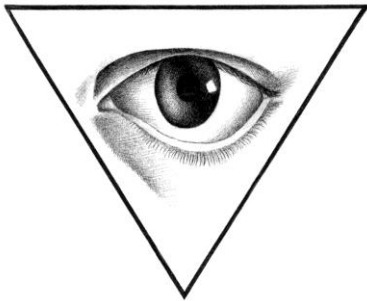




TITLE IX INFORMATION

Sexual Harassment is : UNWANTED
UNWELCOMED
UNSOLICITED
POWER MOTIVATED
ILLEGAL

Definition of Sexual Harassment: Unwanted, unwelcomed and unsolicited sexual advances; requests for sexual favors and other verbal, nonverbal, or physical conduct of a sexual nature when submission to said conduct is made explicitly or implicitly a condition of employment or professional/academic advancement; rejection of such conduct is used as a basis for decisions affecting employment or professional/academic advancement; such conduct has the purpose or effect of unreasonably interfering with a person's work or academic performance, or creating an intimidating, hostile, or offensive work or learning environment. This includes harassment of students by other students, adults by students, students by adults, and adults by adults.



Harassing Behaviors are in the eye of the beholder.
