In January 2023, NCAA Divisions I and II adopted legislation to remove standardized test scores from initial-eligibility requirements for all student-athletes who initially enroll full time on or after August 1, 2023. Check with the NCAA school you plan to attend regarding whether standardized test scores are necessary for admission or scholarship requirements.

South Dakota Opportunity Scholarship

This scholarship provides up to \$6,500 over four years to a qualifying student who attends an eligible higher education institution in South Dakota. Recipients may participate in the South Dakota Opportunity scholarship program for the equivalent of four academic years.

- A minimum GPA of 3.0, or grade of B, is required.
- A minimum ACT composite or Superscore of 24 is required.

Initial eligibility application forms are available in the Counselors' office.

Huron Masonic Lodge Scholarship

Up to 4 applicants will receive \$250.

Applications are available in the counselors' office. Along with completed application, applicants will be asked to answer 3 questions in less than 500-words:

1. How will your chosen career path help you to make your dreams and goals achievable?
2. How will your background help you to achieve and meet the challenges of being an adult in today's world?
3. How will you become involved in the community that you choose to live in to make it a better place in which to live?

Return completed application to the Counselors' Office no later than the last Thursday in April (April 27).

American Legion Baseball Scholarship

Eligibility Requirements

The Player must:

- Attach a copy of his official high school transcript.
- Have graduated from high school.
- Be on a current roster (American Legion National Baseball Electronic Registration Form) filed with National Headquarters.
- Be part of a team affiliated with an American Legion post.
- Have three letters of testimony attached to application.

Applications are due: July 15

Parents of Seniors: Here's What You Should Be Doing in April-May to Prepare for College

April:

~Take a road trip-if your teen has been accepted to more than one college and they are still unsure, now is the time to visit each campus.

~Review Pros and Cons

~Compare financial aid awards.

May:

~Work together: May is full of decisions!

~Be ready for "Decision Day"-May 1 is known as National College Decision Day, or the date your teen needs to notify their school of choice that they're coming. There are also financial requirements that need to be fulfilled. Make sure to review any deposit requirements detailed in your acceptance letter.

~Notify other schools-have your teen send a brief note to the other colleges to thank them and turn down their offers.

~Request a final transcript from the counseling office-your child needs to submit a request for their final high school transcript to be sent to the college they'll be attending. These will be mailed out after final grades are posted.

~Get to know the financial aid office-Find out if there is anything else they need from you.

~Determine if you need additional money to pay for college-if you still need additional aid, consider parent loans or private loans.

And remember, all the emotions you are feeling right now are normal. Amidst this busy time, don't forget to take time as a family. Your soon-to-be college student needs your guidance (and checkbook), but they also just need you to be mom and dad.
