HRMC Youth Healthcare Registered Apprenticeship *11th & 12th Grade Students

The youth apprentice performs nurse aid duties under the supervision of a registered nurse for patients with a well defined nursing diagnosis. Apprentices are required to present an acceptable National Career Readiness Certificate (NCRC), have a satisfactory completion of HRMC's nurse aid training and orientation program, which includes the Department of Labor's Bring Your 'A' Game (BYAG) training. Apprentices will also be required to complete and pass the Southeast Technical Institute CNA and Medical Language Courses.

After completion of the CNA Course, apprentices will perform nurse aid care in a 160-hour paid internship.

Apprentices will have the opportunity to explore areas of healthcare in paid rotating shifts in 3-5 HRMC departments, while completing STC's medical language course. Apprentice will be required to complete a total of 2000 hours of combined coursework and paid on the job training to receive the apprenticeship certificate.

Polar Plunge Campaign and Scholarship
