Athletic Participation Post High School

You can compete at a college/university that is either NCAA (DI, DII, DIII) or NAIA affiliated. Both have different requirements and guidelines.

- NAIA– you need to register with the NAIA Eligibility Center by creating a profile at PlayNAIA.org. NAIA requires students to send specific documentation to be eligible to compete.

College-Bound Seniors (2 or 4 year)

***What should you be doing to succeed?**

- Mark your calendar with registration, admissions, and financial aid deadlines and fees
- Create separate folders for each of the schools that interest you and keep the materials organized.
- Begin writing drafts of your college essays.
- Start completing early admission college applications.
 - FREE college application period: October 12–November 30
- Meet with school representatives who visit your high school.
- Develop a college application resume to highlight your activities, achievements, etc.
- plan to take your ACT—dates are already posted.
- Ask employers, teachers, and counselors for letters of recommendation to accompany your admissions applications.
- Set up your FSA ID (and your parent will need one, too!) and start getting information so you can complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at StudentAid.gov as early as December 2023.
